In **SES GURUKUL** we believe in the holistic development of our children. Our aim is to hone their Life Skills, Creativity, Logical Reasoning and Lateral thinking skills through various activities.

Since we focus on Self Growth, we encourage our children to compete against themselves, rather than with others. Children and staff together set their own goals for continuous improvement in all our fields of endeavour namely, academics, sports, art and crafts and performing arts.

We have students from diverse backgrounds who contribute their individual vitality and unique talent to collectively create a power house of democratic learning. Our main focus is the development of the skills required to succeed in the the 21st century. We believe that we all have a part to play in bringing about this change, that is, 'Learning to Learn'.

We also try to instil values and acquaint the children with the cultural heritage of the country.

Activities like World Book Day, Sanskrit Day, Hindi Diwas, Gurupournima, Vijay Diwas, Ganesh Chaturthi, Durga Puja, Diwali and Christmas are an integral part of the academic calendar. Programmes like Global Jigyasa, Indiation, MUN (Model United Nations) help children to become adept at Public speaking and also build Global citizenship.

A Trans-disciplinary approach is adopted in the school to break barriers between subjects and relating concepts to real life instances with integration of Art and ICT. Hands-on activities for conceptual clarity are undertaken with the focus on Competency based Education with appropriate Learning Outcomes. The Project method has long been an integral part of our teaching methodology.

To achieve these goals, our teachers undergo regular in-service training programmes organised by the COE Pune and other teacher training organisations.
